

Daewoo Precision Industries, Ltd., who was licensed to manufacture the AR-15 and M16A1 Rifles, developed the Daewoo 5.56mm K-series of rifles in the early 21st century. The line was started with the Daewoo K1A1. Numerous recalls and malfunctions plagued the K1A1, and Daewoo released the K2. The K2 was manufactured with a standard buttstock or a folding stock, although frequent failure and breakdown's haunted the line still. The DR-200, chambered for .223 Remington and 5.56 NATO, enabled the use of M16/AR15/M23 magazines. This interchangeability and reuse of current stock magazines enabled the DR-200 to take its rightful place as a squad main weapon for the future.

Popular among Asian tactical units, the DR-200 is light weight, has a high cyclic rate of fire, and comes with an integral Smart Gun Link II™. None of the problems related to the K series have been reported, and the DR-200 has been seen in recent sportsmen shooting competitions.

Whether you want hi-tech or hi-reliability, the DR-200 is the choice for you. Stay true to yourself, go with a Daewoo.
