

GALE'S WALTHER .22 PPK



In 1929 Walter introduced the Polizei Pistole or PP, the first double action pistol. In 1931 Walther introduced a pocket version. The gun differed from the PP in that the barrel and frame had been each been shortened. The internal mechanism was the same, though they utilized a wrap-around plastic grip to give the frame a corrected contour. The firm then came up with the model designation PPK or "Polizei Pistole Kriminal". The name symbolized that it was to be used for covert undercover police work.

These particular versions have been anodized gun metal pink, and, regularly, matching pink .22 longrifle rounds are used.
